Why do we celebrate Easter for 50 days?

In the New Testament book of Acts, we read that after Jesus' resurrection, he spent 40 days teaching his disciples about the kingdom of God before he ascended to heaven (Acts 1:3). He told them to wait for the power of the Holy Spirit so they prayed a novena with Jesus' mother Mary until the Jewish Feast of Pentecost, which is 50 days after the day Jesus died in the Jewish Feast of Passover (Acts 1:1-15). On the fiftieth day, Pentecost, Peter and the first Christians were empowered by the Holy Spirit to preach the good news of Jesus in multiple languages to all the visitors gathered in Jerusalem, and 3,000 baptisms happened that day (Acts 2:1-6,41). By extending the Easter season to include all these events, the Church emphasizes the connection between Jesus' Resurrection, his Ascension into Heaven, and the first Christian s being anointed by the Holy Spirit to carry out Christ's work on earth. By extending Easter for 50 days, we emphasize how important Jesus' resurrection is for the Church. So we keep being joyful. It's still Easter!
