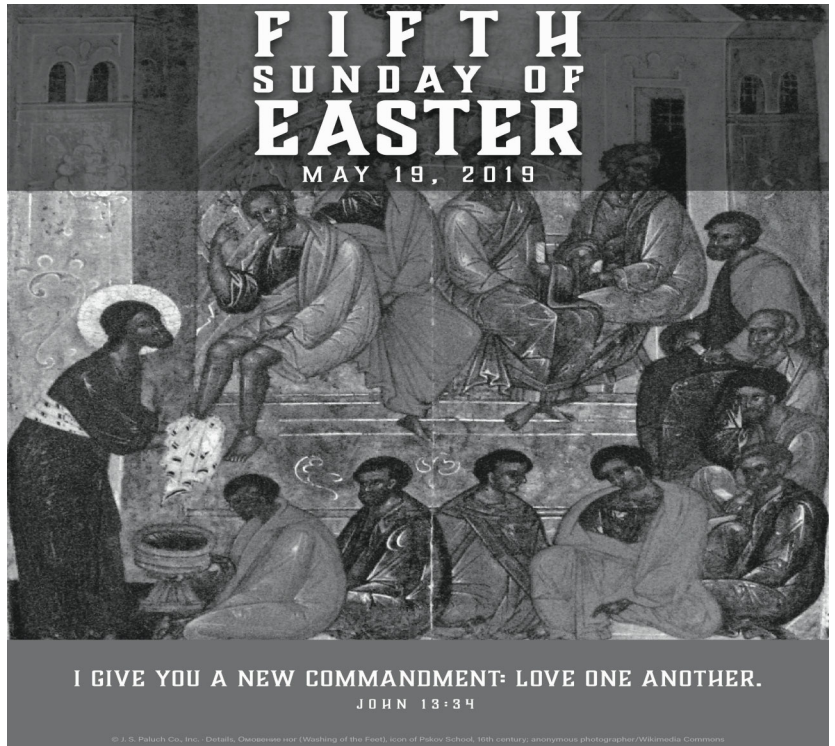

Dear Family of St. Anthony,
