Greetings in the Lord!

I am very eager to begin celebrating our new Wednesday evening Mass this week. I have begun offering this additional Mass as a way to address several issues.

First it will benefit those in our parish who wish to attend daily Mass on Wednesday but who cannot do so at 7:30am. It will also benefit students and members of the Franciscan University of Steubenville who are always in search of Masses in our area to attend.

Second it will increase the time our parish spends in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Formal Exposition, Adoration, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is offered on Fridays at 3pm in conjunction with our Divine Mercy devotion. Wednesday evening Mass will conclude with a holy hour of Exposition, Adoration, and Benediction so that those who cannot come on Friday will have an opportunity to spend time in the presence of the Eucharist.

Third it will permit me another established hour of scheduled availability to hear confessions. While the Eucharist is exposed on the altar following the Wednesday evening Mass I will be available to hear confessions in addition to the hour of confessions scheduled on Saturdays.

BIBLE STUDY will be canceled this week.

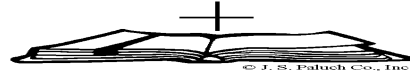
