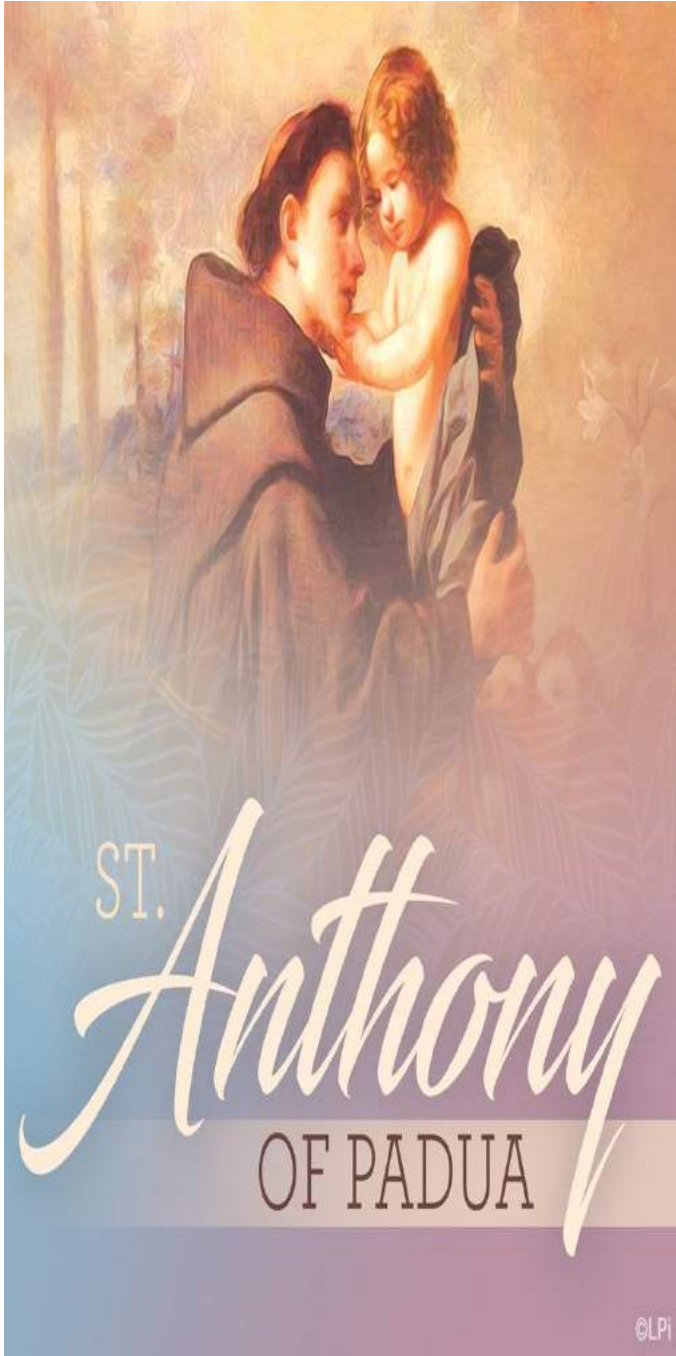

We do we celebrate Sunday as Corpus Christi?

Corpus Christi means "body of Christ." It is the day we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, present to us in the Eucharist. The Church has been celebrating Corpus Christi for about 760 years. St. Juliana, a nun in Belgium, noticed in prayer that Holy Thursday was too sad a day to celebrate the Eucharist joyfully, and spoke to others about God's desire that a new feast day be added. Eventually, her diocese began this new celebration. A priest from her diocese later became pope, and asked St. Thomas Aquinas to help with writing new prayers for the new feast. In 1264, Pope Urban IV introduced the feast of Corpus Christi for the Thursday after Pentecost. Week. In modern times, it has been moved to the following Sunday so that all may celebrate the gift of the Eucharist joyfully

St. Thomas Aquinas wrote about the Eucharist, "O precious and wonderful banquet, that brings us salvation and contains all sweetness! Could anything be of more intrinsic value? Here Christ himself. The true God, is set before us as our food What could be more wonderful than this? Through it sins are purged away, virtues are increased, and the soul is enriched with an abundance of every spiritual gift. No one can fully express the sweetness of this sacrament, in which spiritual delight is tasted at its very source, and in which we renew the memory of that surpassing love for us hich Christ revealed in His Passion.
