EUCHARISTIC REFLECTIONWhy do we offer the Mass?

Today in the readings, we will hear Jesus described as an “offering for sin,” and he will say he came to “give his life as a ransom for many.” The readings also say that He is a priest who can “sympathize with our weaknesses” and so we should “confidently approach the throne of grace to receive mercy and to find grace for timely help.” That is what the Mass is for. The Eucharistic prayers say that we offer the Mass for ourselves and all who are dear to us, “for the redemption of their souls, in hope of health and well-being.” We ask that Christ’s sacrifice and merciful help be given to us and those we love.
